





SEASON PASS INFORMATION

All persons entering the pool must have a valid season pass or pay the daily fee. Children two years and under will be admitted at no charge. The second pass price listed is the non-resident membership rate. There is a \$5 replacement charge for lost or stolen passes. Full facility rules and regulations, as well as special hours, are posted at the Algonquin Swimming Pool, and on our website: www.algonquin.org/pool.

PICKING UP SEASON PASSES

All season pass holders should bring their receipt when visiting pool for the first time. New season pass holders will pick up their key tags the first time they visit the pool, while renewing season pass holders' key tags from the prior season will be reactivated within 72 hours of payment. Starfish Swim Lessons

The Village of Algonquin is an independent authorized provider of Starfish Swimming. Starfish Swimming is a nationally recognized swim instruction curriculum developed by the Starfish Aquatics Institute (SAI). Learn more about SAI at www.starfishaquatics.org

The Starfish Swimming curriculum is designed for students ages 6-months to adult. Benchmarks are established at each stage in the program that combine both swimming and safety skills. Students participate in experiential learning activities that allow them to explore the water in a creative and comfortable environment. Correct swimming techniques are taught from the very beginning, providing an easy transition to swim team.

StarBabies (Age 6 months-2 years) StarTots (Ages 18 Months-3 years)

This course is a parent/child program that introduces infants and toddlers to the water in a fun and loving environment. Parents or caregivers are taught effective techniques to teach their infants and toddlers how to float, submerge, move in the water, and roll over to breathe. Classes incorporate songs, activities, and water safety education.



Starfish Swim School for Preschoolers (Ages 3-5 years)

Designed to meet the needs of children ages 3 to 5, this course will develop a high comfort level in the water and a readiness to swim, and for those children who are developmentally ready, it will teach functional swim skills. This class approaches teaching swimming through creative, fun activities in the water. Students work toward developing the five competencies and progress toward achieving the benchmarks at their own pace in a small-group setting.

Starfish Swim School (Ages 6 years - Adult)

This program is for youth and adult students to develop a foundation of swimming and safety skills with a focus on self-rescue:

- * trust and submersion
- * body positions and air recovery (includes rollover to back for air recovery)
- * forward movement and direction change
- * rotary movement (transitions from rollover to side position for air recovery)
- * integrated movement
- * age-appropriate safety skills such as asking permission, wearing a lifejacket, using flotation to make an assist, treading water and survival float

Starfish Stroke School (Ages 6 years-Adult)

The Stroke School for youth and adult students develops effective swim technique and endurance for:

- * Freestyle
- * Backstroke
- * Butterfly
- * Breaststroke

Inclement Weather Policy:

All lessons are taught at an outdoor facility and it is not uncommon for lessons to be cancelled due to inclement weather. Lessons will generally be held if the temperature is 65 degrees or higher, as we do have a heated pool. It is the responsibility of the participants to check on the status of class when weather looks questionable or is inclement. To check the status of class, download the Rainout Line App or call the weather line at (847) 999-0225 no more than one hour prior to class start time. If cancelled due to inclement weather or other reasons determined by the Village, swimmers will have a scheduled makeup class. If more than two lessons in a session are cancelled by the Village, a credit will be applied to the family's account for future use. Credits and/or prorates are not issued to students who cannot attend makeup date.

Who are Residents of Algonquin?

You are considered a resident of the Village of Algonquin if you pay taxes to the Village and reside within the Village boundaries. Fees are listed Resident (R) or Non-Resident (NR). Registration forms will not be accepted without the proper fees included. If you are uncertain whether you qualify as a Village of Algonquin resident, please check your current property tax bill. Proof of residency in the form of a current tax bill or utility bill may be required during the registration process.

Waiver Form

The Village is unable to assume responsibility for injuries or accidents occurring during programs and activities or at parks and facilities. Such insurance would make program user fees prohibitive. The Insurance Liability Waiver section of the registration form must be signed when registering yourself or your minor child to participate in a program.


